### Selection of Village Level Entrepreneur for Common Service Centers

The 'Haryana e-Seva Scheme for Common Service Centers, 2014' has been notified vide No. Admn/299/1SIT/2290 dated 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2015 for the establishment of Common Service Centers (CSC) at each Gram Panchayat throughout the state of Haryana, in a phased manner, following a Private Entrepreneurship Business Model, in line with the approach envisaged by Government of India. These CSCs shall serve as key public interface points for delivery of electronic services from Government Departments and Agencies (G2C), Private sector services (B2C) and a variety of other relevant services to the citizens. Under this model, a Village/Urban Level Entrepreneur shall be selected as the CSC operator that will be identified at various locations in each district. Accordingly, eligible persons who possess entrepreneurial abilities, with capability to invest upwards of Rs.1.65 lakhs, with knowledge and experience of working in a computer enabled environment and a strong aptitude to establish a successful citizen centric operation are invited to apply for the same.

Locations where CSCs are planned to be opened is given below:-

In All Gram Panchayats of District Mewat except those Panchayats in which CSC Center is already established. Details of such Panchayats are available on the official website of District Mewat i.e. <http://mewat.gov.in/csc.html>
